### 1. Educational and other Qualifications for Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) Post

#### Essential

(i) Three years Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks OR equivalent GPA in the subject(s) concerned or combination of subjects and as well as in aggregate or equivalent CGPA and B.Ed. degree from a recognized University. **OR**

Four years Integrated Bachelor's Degree with B.Ed. degree of Regional Institute of Education of NCERT / from any National Council for Teacher Education recognized institution with at least 50% of Marks or equivalent GPA in the subject(s) concerned or combination of subjects as well as in aggregate or equivalent CGPA.

(ii) Pass in Paper-II of Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) conducted by the CBSE.

(iii) Proficiency in teaching in English Medium (except for TGT Hindi/Sanskrit).

(iv) Desirable: Working knowledge of Hindi and Computers.

3	TGT (Hindi / Sanskrit)	Hindi or Sanskrit as a subject in graduation for all the three years and B.Ed. with Hindi or Sanskrit as a teaching subject.
4	TGT (Maths / Physics)	Mathematics and Physics in graduation in at least two years and B.Ed. with any subject of science as a teaching subject.

		Pass in Senior Secondary / Higher Secondary School Certificate Test or Intermediate or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA in aggregate with English as subject in +2 level and four years Bachelor's degree in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed) from recognized Institution.
		<b>OR</b>
		Pass in Senior Secondary / Higher Secondary School Certificate Test or Intermediate or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA in aggregate with English as subject in +2 level and two years Diploma in Education (D.Ed) from recognized Institution.

		Graduation in any subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA and Bachelor's of Education (B.Ed)

### **MODE OF SELECTION**

- i. **Written Test** - Objective type of test (MCQs) for 50 marks in the respective subject for 1½ hour. Candidates scoring 50% or above (Gen) and 45% or above (SC/ST/OBC/PH) will be considered for Skill test.
- ii. **Skill Test** – For the candidates short-listed on the basis of written test. It will be Go / No Go method.  
The Selected candidates will be empanelled and will be operated as and when vacancies arise in AEC Schools, Hyderabad during the Academic Year 2019-20.

### **General Instructions**

1. All the age relaxations mentioned above will be concurrent, i.e., if a person is eligible for more than one concession, only one of the concessions of the highest permissible limit will be granted.
2. The selected candidates will be empanelled and the panel will be operated as and when the vacancy arises in AEC, Schools, Hyderabad during the Academic Year 2020-21.
3. Wherever marks are mentioned as GPF/CGPA, it is to be understood as marks obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University / Institution's norms. The transcripts issued by the university / institutions have to be produced.
4. Candidates with B.Ed in Special Education are not eligible for these posts.
5. Candidates must submit application along with the complete bio-data giving details of age, qualification, experience and address for correspondence with contact numbers, e-mail id and a passport size photograph in the school at the time of Registration. A set of attested photocopies of all mark sheets and certificates must be attached with the application.
6. Candidates must bring the original certificates for verification. Candidates not bringing the original certificates will not be allowed to appear for the written test.
7. Candidates must submit separate applications for each post, if applying for more than one post.
8. No TA/DA is admissible for attending the written test and skill test for the candidates.
9. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
